Contemporary ZEN




The strong contrast of two colors and the bold graphic stitched initial taken from OESD Zenspirations design collection make this piece of contemporary wall art something that makes a statement about you. Start with a deep color such as black, navy blue, or red. Add a bright coordinating color for contrast and pull the look together with mixed ribbons and buttons.

Finished size: 12" x 12"

Supplies

- BERNINA Embroidery System
- Large Oval Hoop
- 2 pieces of OESD heavy cut-away stabilizer, 12" x 12" each
- 101 Quilt Basting Spray
- 12" x 12" piece of felt in deep color such as black, navy blue, or red (color 1)
- Isacord embroidery thread in colors 1 & 2
- 12" x 12" background fabric in a bright coordinating color (color 2) Note: The background fabric can be solid, or for more interest look for subtle prints or textures.
- 12" of 11/2"-wide ribbon in color 1 (shown in black)
- 12" of 1"-wide ribbon that combines or coordinates with colors 1 & 2 (shown in green and black)
- 11/4 yard of 5%"-wide ribbon in a coordinating ribbon (shown in black & white check)
- Lite Steam-A-Seam Fusible Tape, 1/2"-wide
- 4 small decorative buttons in color 2
- 12" x 12" decorative frame (scrapbook-type frame)
- Edgestitch Foot #10/10C/10D
- Button Sew-On Foot #18

Preparation

- 1. Using the quilt basting spray, adhere one piece of cut-away to the wrong side of the felt and one to the wrong side of the background fabric.
- 2. Hoop the stabilized felt, approximately in the center of the square.

Stitching the Letter

- 3. Select the large, 1-color letter of your choice; the size will be approximately 6" tall.
- 4. Stitch the letter in the center of the hoop using Isacord thread.
- 5. Remove the hoop from the machine but do not remove the stabilizer.
- 6. Trim the felt/stabilizer, leaving at least 1" around all sides of the letter. Note: The final size of this piece will vary depending on the letter. The sample shown is approximately 6" x 7". Set aside.

Preparing the Background

- 7. Center the 2-color ribbon on top of the wide ribbon. Using Edgestitch Foot #10/10C/10D, stitch the ribbon in place along the side edges.
- 8. Position the layered ribbons across the stabilized background fabric, at the horizontal center; edgestitch in place.



- Place the trimmed felt piece in the center of the background square, placing it on top of the layered ribbons; baste in place.
- 10. Cut the remaining ribbon into 4 equal pieces. Lay them along the edges of the basted felt piece and trim the ribbons to the approximate size needed.
- 11. Cut 4 pieces of Lite Steam-A-Seam Fusible Tape to match the trimmed ribbons. Peel the tape from the paper and press one piece to the wrong side of each of the four ribbon pieces.
- 12. Place one piece of ribbon over each side edge of the felt with about 1" extending on each end. Following the manufacturer's directions, fuse the ribbon in place.
- 13. Repeat with the two remaining ribbons and the upper and lower edges of the felt. Note: The ribbon can be stitched after fusing for added security.

Finishing

14. Stitch the decorative buttons in the corners where the ribbons overlap; place finished piece in frame.
