Assembly

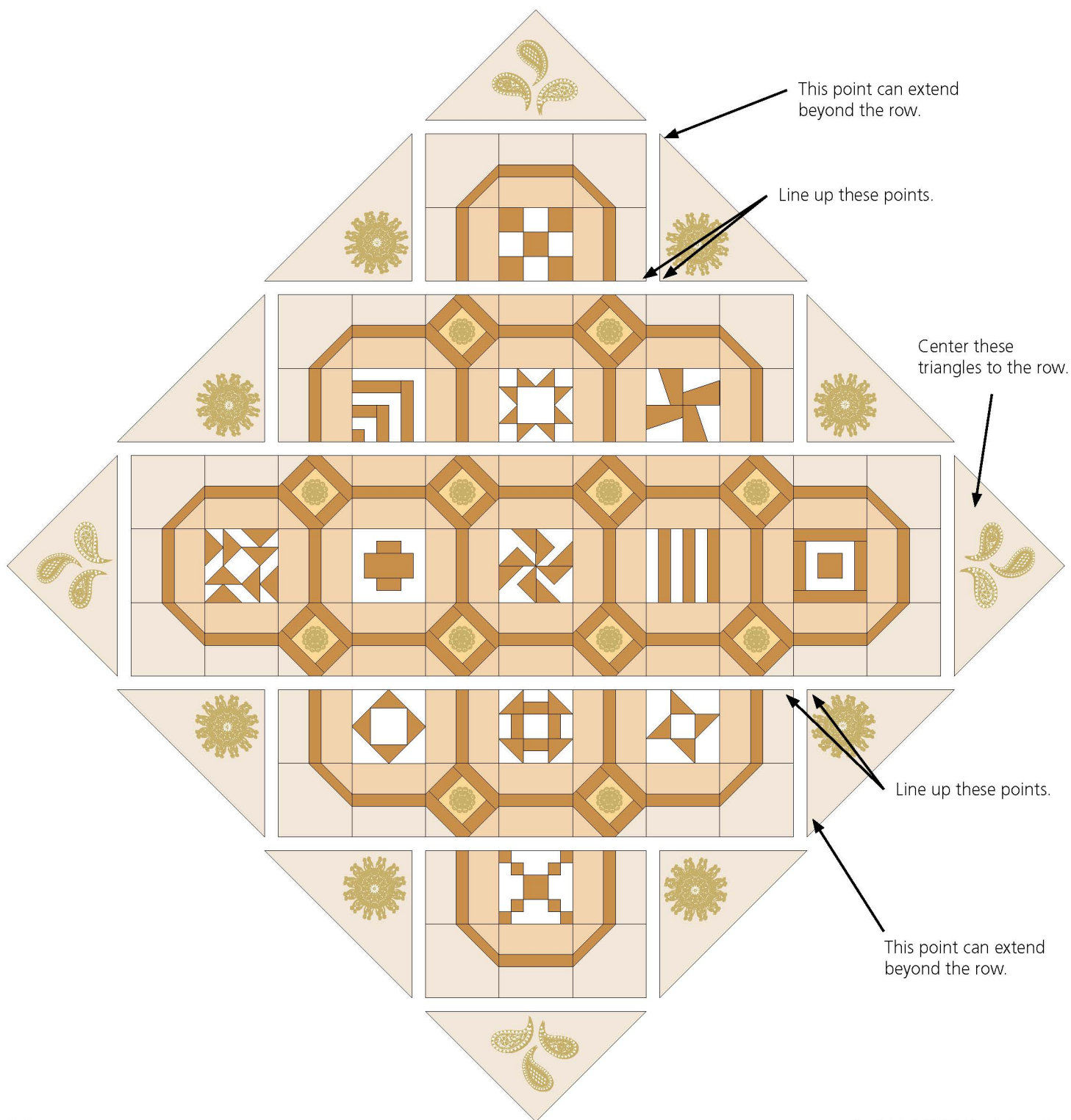
Following the diagram below, join the blocks into rows, pressing the seams toward the Sashing blocks and away from the Cornerstone blocks.

Join the triangle blocks onto the ends of the rows as shown, pressing the seams toward the center of the rows. The square corners of the triangles should be flush with the raw edge of the rows—it is okay if the triangle points extend beyond the rows!

Trim the triangle points that extend beyond the rows. Join the rows.

Trim the quilt top so that all the points where the seams meet are 1/4" in from the edge of the top. Join a Fabric D rectangle 3-1/4" x 60" to each side of the quilt top. Join a Fabric D rectangle 3-1/4" x 65-1/2" to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

Note: If you prefer not to do embroidery in the borders you will probably want to trim the quilt top smaller before adding borders so that the scale of the borders is more in keeping with the scale of the quilt center.
