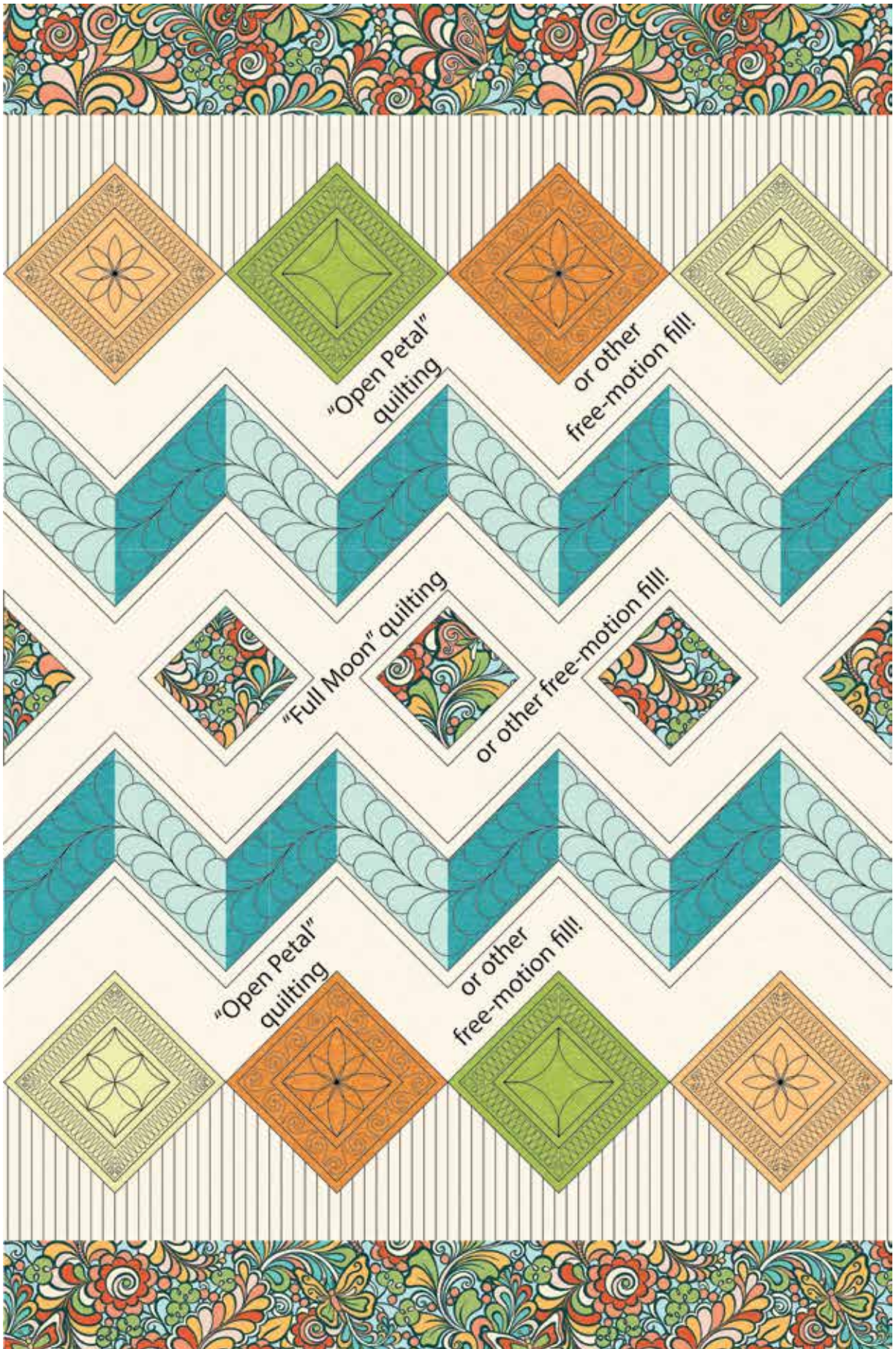


Diamonds Quilting Month 3

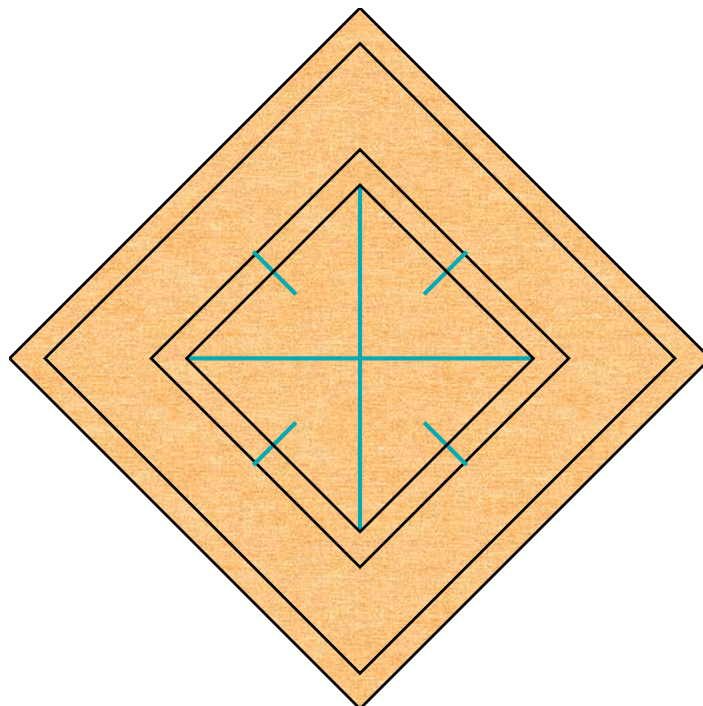
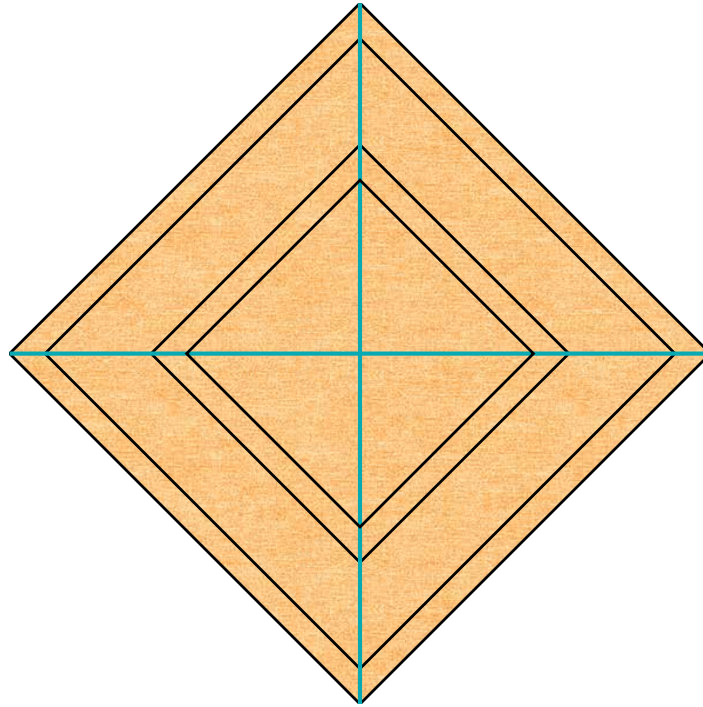


Quilting Month 3

Framework

For each diamond you'll begin by quilting a framework in its coordinating thread color. To do this, mark the horizontal and vertical center of the quilted diamond by connecting its corners using your marking tool of choice - this line will help you to know where to change directions. Use the Every Angle ruler to echo a Diamond $1/2''$ inside the seamlines. Echo another diamond $1-1/2''$ inside this new quilted line. Echo a third diamond $1/2''$ inside that quilted line.

For just the first, third, and fourth diamonds:
Remark the horizontal and vertical centers within the inner diamond by connecting its corners to find their exact center point, in case quilting shifted things a bit. Mark the midpoint of the inner diamonds' sides.



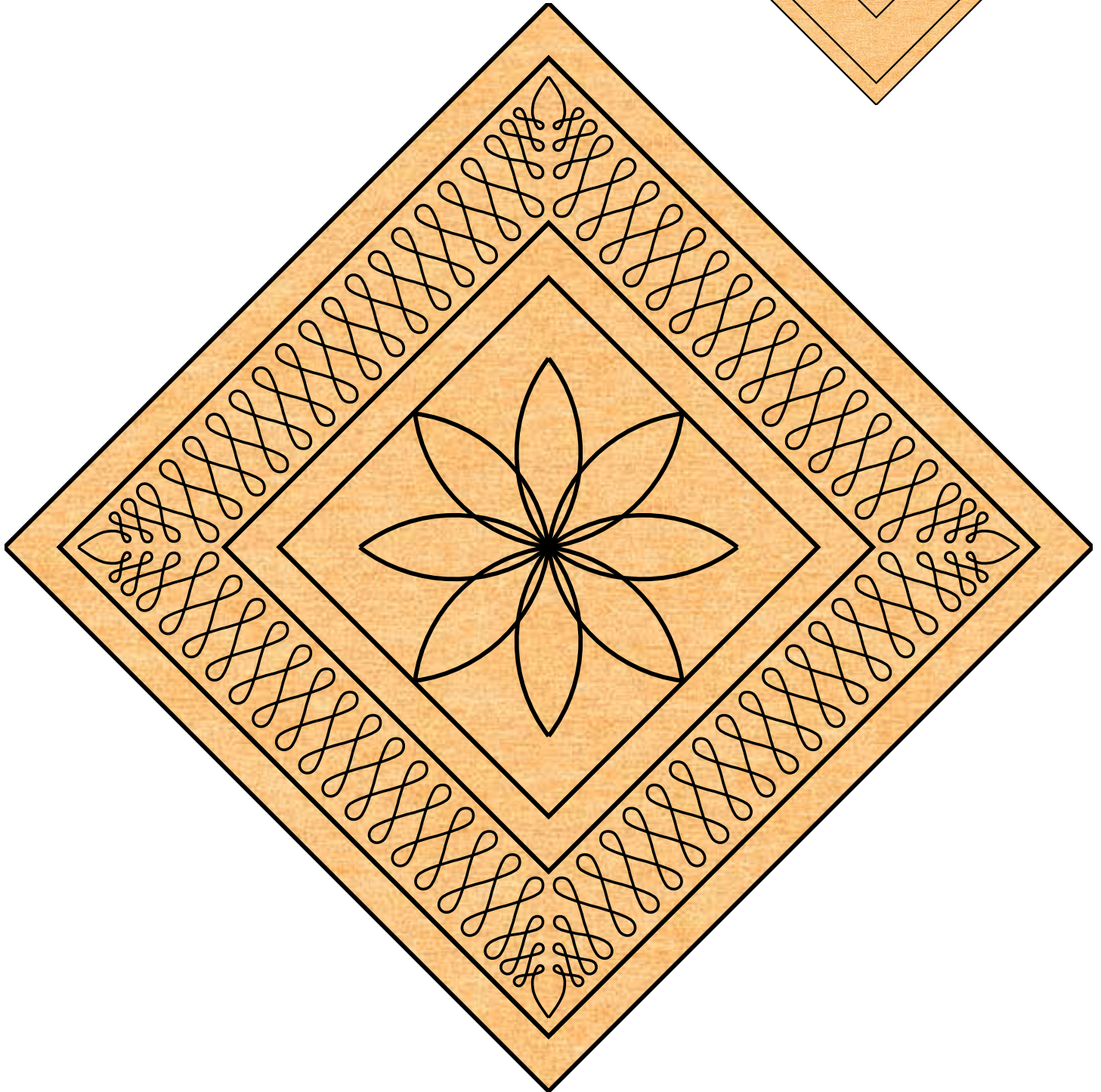
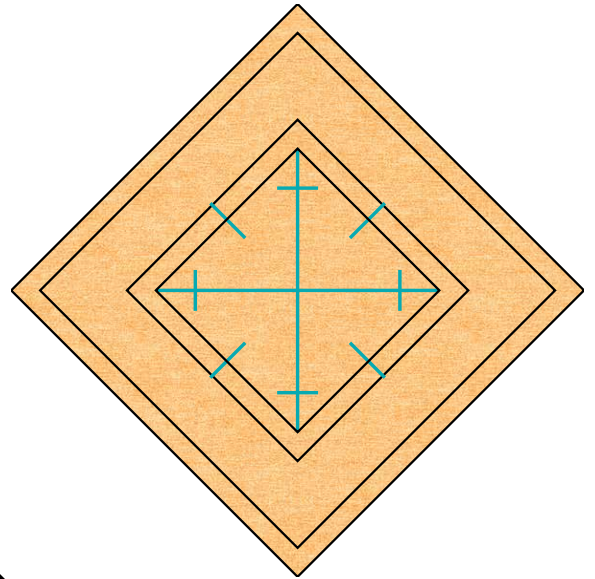
Diamond 1

Make a mark 2-1/2" from the center of the diamond on each side of its horizontal and vertical centerlines.

Without ending your thread, use the 4" Every Circle ruler to connect the center of the diamond to these marks and the center of the diamond to the midpoints of its edges.

Free-motion around this motif if desired.

Quilt fishbones in the channel.

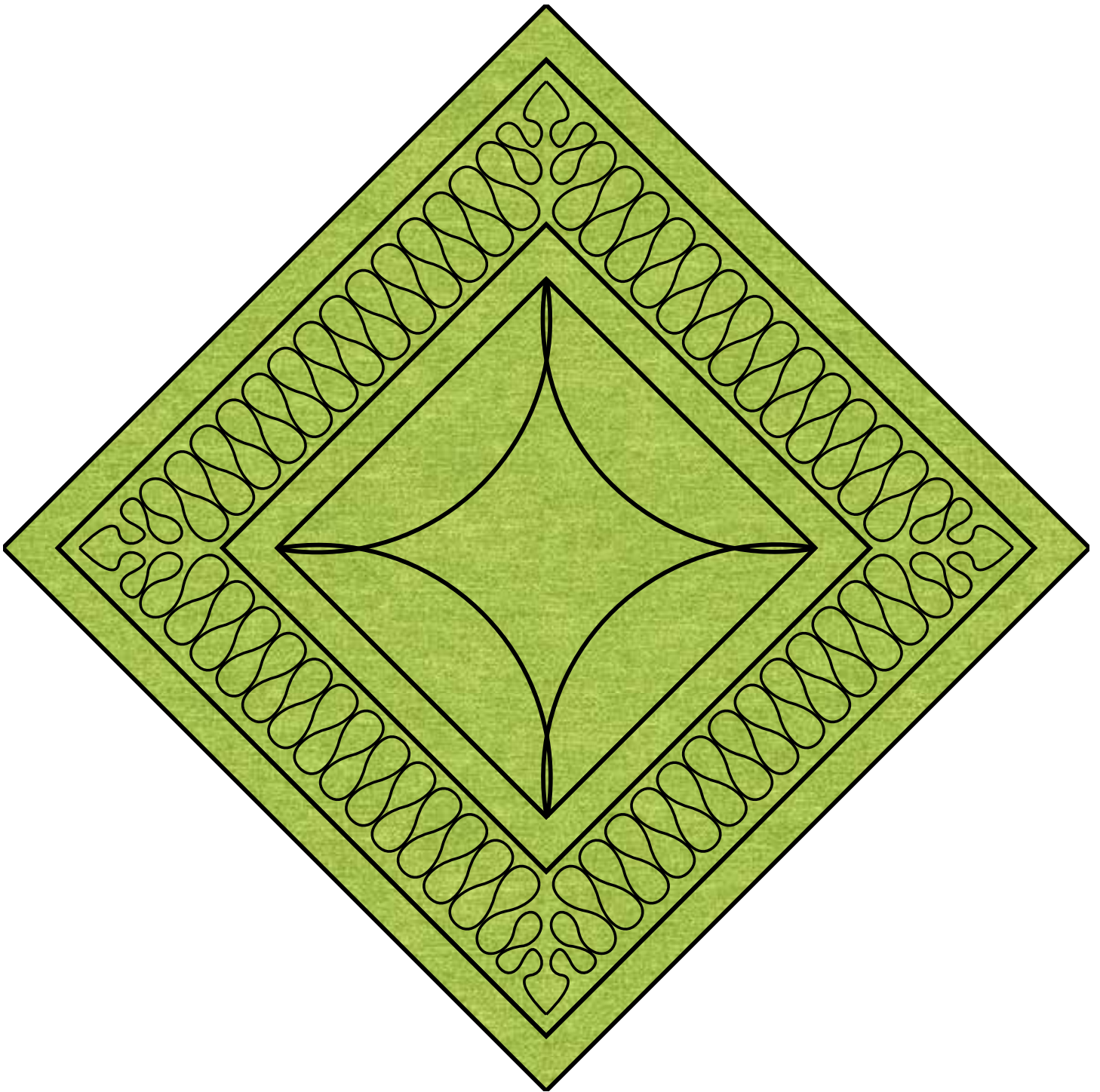


Diamond 2

Use the use the 6" Every Circle ruler to connect the corners of the diamond.

Free-motion inside this motif if desired.

Quilt ribbon candy in the channel.

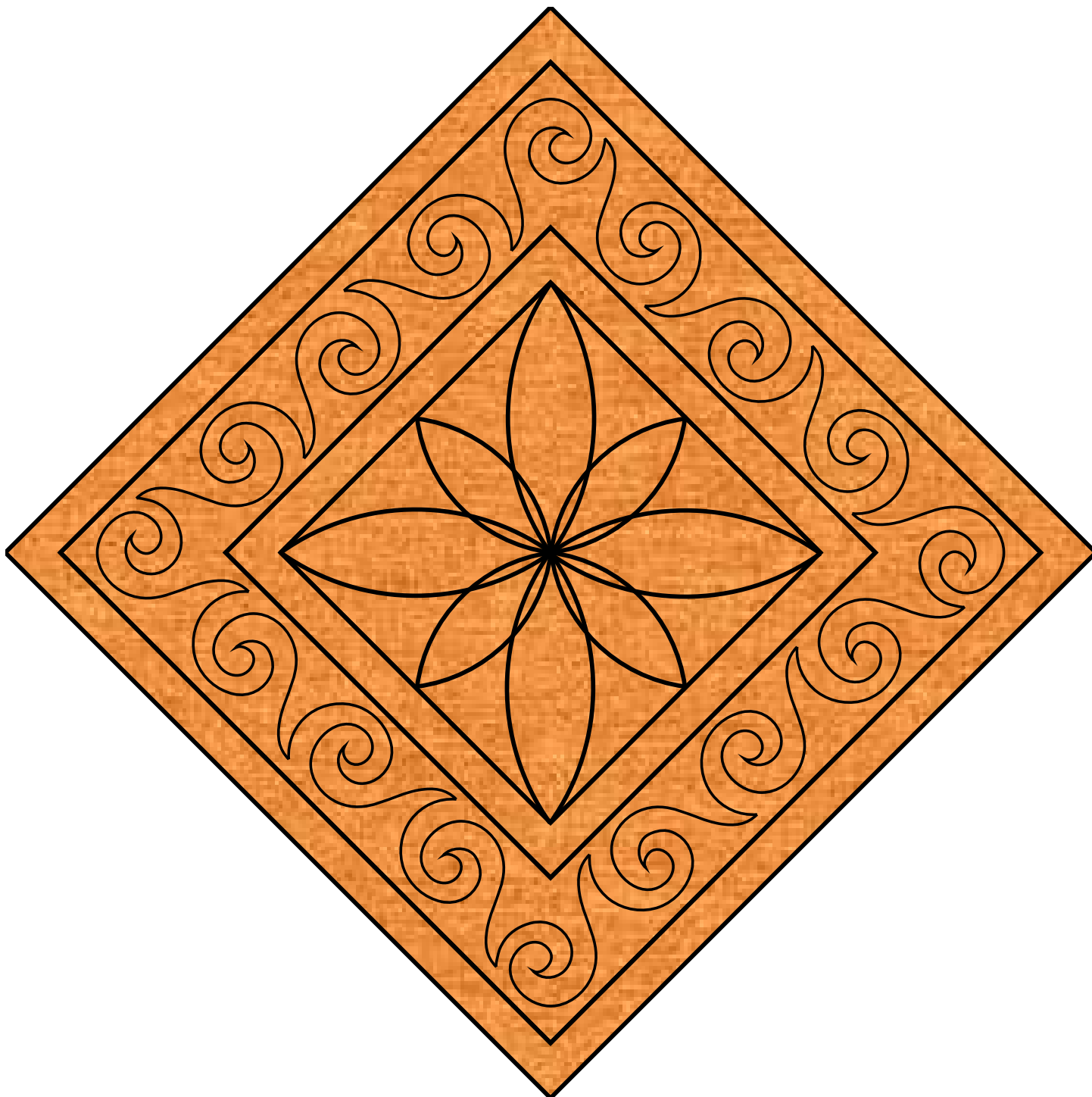


Diamond 3

Use the 6" Every Circle ruler to connect the center of the diamond to its corners and use the 4" Every Circle ruler to connect the center of the diamond to the midpoints of its edges.

Free-motion around this motif if desired.

Quilt swirls in the channel.



Diamond 4

Following the diagram below, use the 4" Every Circle ruler to connect the corners of the diamond with the midpoints of its edges. Then connect the midpoints of the edges with the diamond's center until you have completed the motifs.

Free-motion inside these motifs if desired.

Quilt loops in the channel.

You are done quilting the Diamonds Quilt!

Join the 2-1/4" wide binding strips into 1 continuous piece for binding. Press, folding in half lengthwise. Join the binding to quilt on the front, hand stitching to the back to secure.
