CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

- Includes ¼" seam allowance
- WOF: width of fabric Yardage: about 42"- 44"

Fat quarter (FQ) & Fat eighth: about 21"- 22"

(Unless mentioned otherwise)

NOTE: The letters (A through N) in **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS** are linked with both "MAKE THE BLOCKS" and "ASSEMBLE THE QUILT TOP". Please label all parts according to the instructions.

COLOR 1: Cut (1) 4"x WOF, cross cut into:

- (4) 4"x 3" rectangles B
- (4) 4"x 6 1/2" rectangles C

COLOR 2: Cut (6) 3"x WOF, from (3) strips, cross cut into:

- (6) 3"x 10" rectangles J
- (2) 3"x 12 1/2" rectangles K
- (3) strips for the inner border **L** set aside.

COLOR 3: Cut (6) 3"x WOF, from (2) strips, cross cut into:

- (4) 3"x 7" rectangles F
- (4) 3"x 9 1/2" rectangles G
- (4) strips for the outer border **M/N** set aside.

COLOR 4: Cut (1) 3"x WOF, cross cut into:

(10) 3"x 3" squares - A

Cut (4) 1"x WOF, cross cut into:

- (4) 1"x 10" rectangles I
- (4) 1"x 9 1/2" rectangles H
- (4) 1"x 7" rectangles E
- (4) 1"x 6 1/2" rectangles **D**

Binding: Cut (4) 2 ½"x WOF




MAKING THE BLOCKS

Press all the seam allowance in the direction of the arrows.


1. With the right sides together (RST), piece Square **A** and Rectangle **B** together and press.




2. RST, piece Rectangle **C** to the unit from STEP 1 together and press.




3. RST, piece Rectangle **D** to the right side of the unit from STEP 2, press. Piece Rectangle **E** to the bottom of the unit and press.




4. RST, piece Rectangle **F** to the right side of the unit from STEP 3. Piece Rectangle **G** to the bottom of the unit and press.



5. RST, piece Rectangle **H** to the right side of the unit from STEP 4, press. Piece Rectangle **I** to the bottom of the unit and press. Repeat the STEPS 1-5 and **make 4 units.**





MAKE THE INNER AND OUTER BORDERS

Piece the short edge of the strips together and make a long strip, measure and cut as indicated in the table below.

INNER	CUTTING	
BORDERS		
L	(4) 3"x 24 ½"	

OUTER BORDERS	CUTTING
M	(2) 3"x 29 ½"
N	(2) 3"x 34 ½"



ASSEMBLE THE QUILT TOP


Lay out the blocks as shown in the diagram below. Piece each row, and then sew the pieced rows together, press.



Inner border


RST, piece (2) strip L to both sides as shown in the diagram right, press.

RST, piece squares A to both ends of each strip L, then sew the pieced strips to the top and bottom, press.




Outer border

RST, piece strip M to both sides, then piece strips N to the top and bottom, press.



COMPLETE THE QUILT

To make the quilt sandwich, you need the quilt top, batting and backing fabric. Use your preferred method to baste, quilt and bind. The cutting table shows to use 2 ½" wide strips for the binding. This is my preferred width but feel free to use the width you like.


