
### MONTH 2: BLOCK ASSEMBLY--HEART & FLOWER APPLIQUE BLOCKS



Finished Size: 10" x 10" Number to Make: 2

- 1. Trace applique shapes on the paper side of the fusible web leaving  $\frac{1}{2}$ " between shapes.
  - Hearts 8
  - Stems 8
  - Leaves 16
  - Buds 8
  - Bud Base 8
- 2. Roughly cut the shapes from the fusible web leaving about a 1/4" around outside drawn line.
- 3. If using a fusible with paper on both sides, remove paper on the reverse side and position shapes on the wrong side of each particular fabric as listed below. Position so that there is 1/4" 1/2" spacing between shapes. Fuse following manufacturer's instructions.
  - Fabric D Heart
  - Fabric E Bud
  - Fabric F Stem, Leaf and Bud Base
- 4. Cut out each fused shape on drawn lines.
- 5. Fold **A Square** in quarters on both straight and diagonals and finger press to create orientation lines.
- 6. Remove the fusible web paper and position shapes referring to the block diagram using orientation lines as a reference. Position heart shapes on horizontal and vertical folds approximately 1-3/4" from center of block. Position flowers on the diagonal folds, layering Bloom and Stem shapes under the Bloom Base shape.



- 7. When satisfied with placement, fuse in place.
- Applique around each shape using a machine blanket stitch. The sample was stitched using the **Blanket Stitch** set at 2.5mm x 2.5mm with an **Open Embroidery Foot #20** using Isacord 40 thread:
  - #4032 heart shapes,
  - #5515 leaf, stem and bud base shapes
  - #0608 bud shapes.
- 9. Trim all threads and press block. Square to 10-1/2" x 10-1/2".
- 10. Repeat to make two blocks.

#### **MONTH 2: BLOCK ASSEMBLY--DIAMOND HEART APPLIQUE UNITS**



Finished Size: 7" x 10" Number to Make: 6

- 1. Trace six heart applique shapes on the paper side of the fusible web leaving  $\frac{1}{2}$ " between shapes. Cut out each shape with a ¼" margin.
- 2. If using a fusible with paper on both sides, remove paper on the reverse side and position shapes on the wrong side of **Fabric D** with a 1/4'' - 1/2'' spacing between shapes. Fuse following manufacturer's instructions.
- 3. Cut out each shape on the drawn line.
- 4. Fold **B Rectangles** in half both directions and finger press to create orientation lines.
- 5. Remove paper and position the heart shape in the center of the **B** rectangle using the orientation lines.

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- 6. When satisfied with placement, fuse in place.
- 7. Applique around each shape using a machine blanket stitch. The sample was stitched using the Blanket Stitch set at 2.5mm x 2.5mm and Open Embroidery Foot #20. Use Isacord 40 color #4032 to match heart shapes. <u>Step 9</u>
- 8. Trim all threads and press.

9. Using provided cutting template, center and trim B to the diamond shape.

10. Stitch **C triangles** to opposite sides of the diamond, press seams






- 11. Stitch **D triangles** on the remaining sides to complete the diamond heart applique block; press. Trim block, if needed to mea-
- 12. Referring to the unit diagram, stitch 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" E strip to the bottom of each rectangle to complete the unit.
- 13. Repeat to make a total of six blocks


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#### **MONTH 2: BLOCK ASSEMBLY--FLORAL APPLIQUE BLOCKS**



Finished Size: 5" x 5" Number to Make: 20

- 1. Trace applique shapes on the paper side of the fusible web leaving  $\frac{1}{2}$ " between shapes.
  - Stems 20
  - Leaves 40
  - **Buds** 20
  - Bud Base 20
- 2. Cut shapes apart leaving a ¼" allowance around drawn line.
- 3. If using a fusible with paper on both sides, remove paper on the reverse side and position shapes on the wrong side of the fabric as listed with a 1/4" 1/2" spacing between shapes. Fuse following manufacturer's instructions.
  - Fabric E Bud
  - Fabric F Stem, Leaf and Bud Base
- 4. Cut out fused shapes on drawn lines.
- 5. Fold an **F square** in half on one diagonal and finger press to create orientation lines.



- 6. Remove fusible web paper and position shapes referring to the block diagram using orientation line as a reference. Position flowers on the diagonal fold, layering Bloom and Stem shapes under the Bloom Base shape.
- 7. When satisfied with placement, fuse in place.
- Applique around each shape using a machine blanket stitch. The sample was stitched using the **Blanket Stitch** set at 2.5mm x 2.5mm with an **Open Embroidery Foot #20**. Use Isacord 40 thread as follows:
  - #5515 leaf, stem and bud base shapes
  - #0608 to match bud shapes.
- 9. Trim all threads and press block. Square to 5-1/2" x 5-1/2".
