

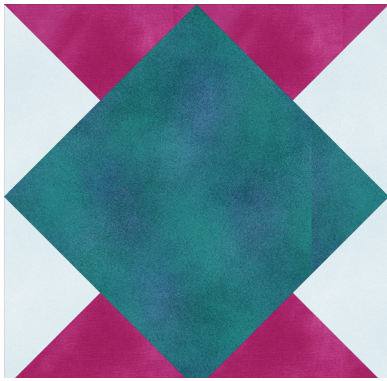
JUMP FOR JOY QUILT ALONG

BLOCK ASSEMBLY--DIAMOND BLOCKS



Finished Size: 5" x 5"
Number to Make: 20

1. Arrange and join a **M and N triangle** as shown to make a **M-N unit**; press seam open. Repeat to make 40.
2. Arrange and join a **N and M triangle** as shown to make a **Reverse M-N unit**; press seam open. Repeat to make 40.
3. Sew a **M-N unit** from Step 1 to opposite sides of a **L square**; press seam toward L. Repeat to make 20.
4. Referring to the block diagram, sew a **Reverse M-N unit** from Step 2 to the remaining sides of the unit from Step 3 to make complete one **Diamond Block**; press. Trim block, if needed, to measure 5-1/2" x 5-1/2". Make 20.
